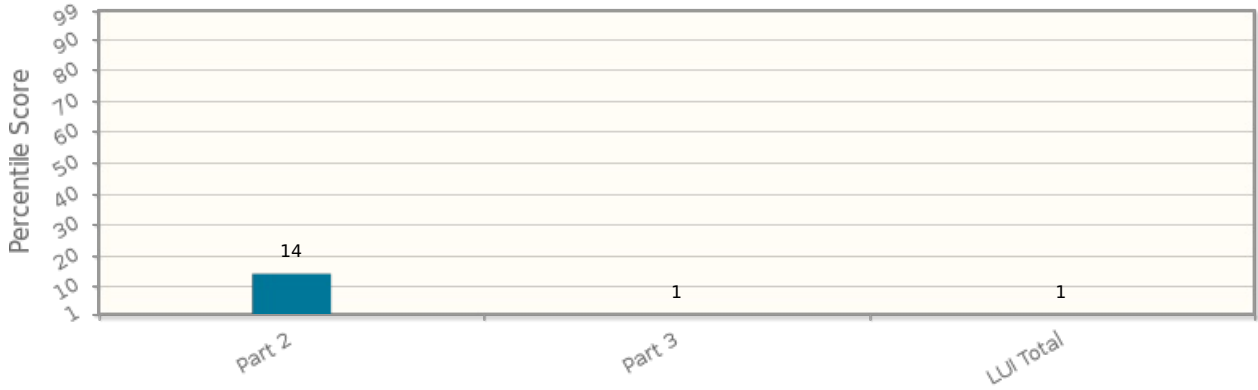
Child's Overall Performance on the LUI

How this child's score compares to a representative sample of 100 35-month-old girls.

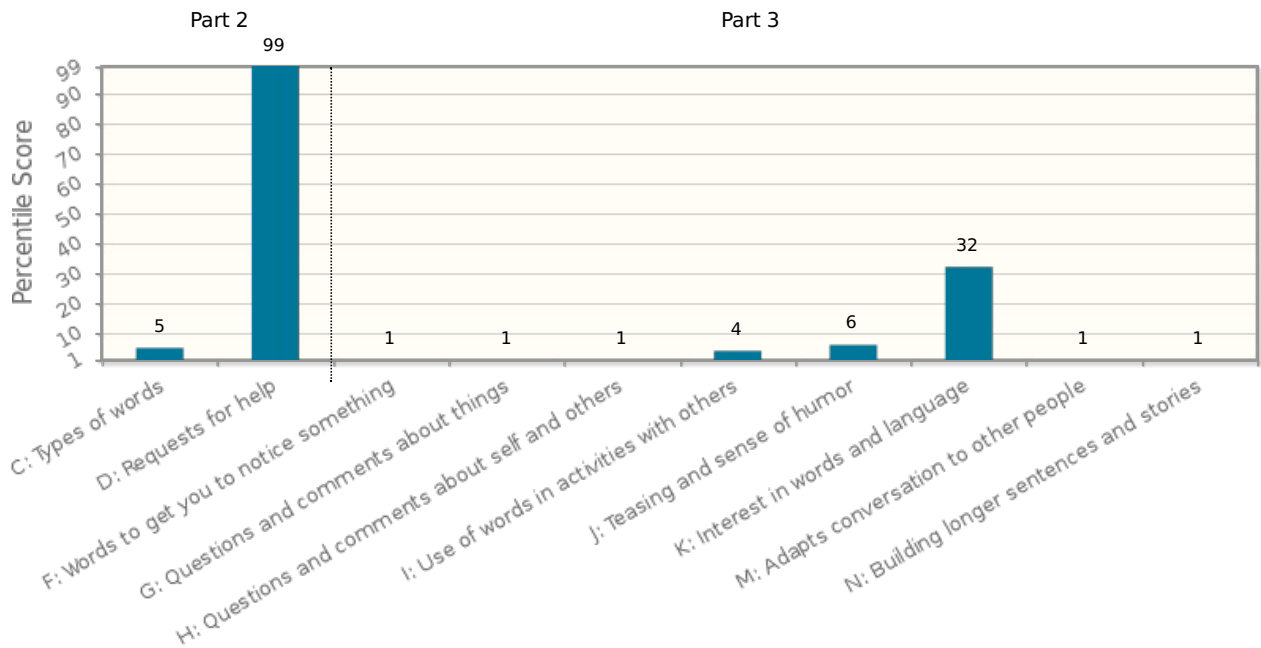
